

## **Kiwanis Foundation of Metropolitan Kenosha 2014 Academic Scholarship Program**

The Kiwanis Foundation of Metropolitan Kenosha is pleased to announce the availability of its annual scholarships. Four scholarships will be awarded to senior high school students who, upon graduation, plan to attend an accredited two or four-year college, university, or technical school. The Scholarships vary in amount: \$2,000; \$1,500; \$1,250; & \$500. **Application Deadline: Friday, March 28, 2014.**

### **Eligibility**

1. High School senior graduating by August of the year the application is made.
2. High School senior must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better (on a scale of 4.0).
3. Scholarship awards may be used for any two- or four-year accredited, post-secondary program. The \$500 scholarship is reserved for a two year technical college.
4. Must be enrolled as a student at one of the following High Schools: Mary D. Bradford, Christian Life, Indian Trail, Kenosha E School, Lakeview Academy, Reuther Central, St. Joseph Academy, Shoreland Lutheran, or Tremper.
5. The \$1500 scholarship will be awarded to an active member of the Bradford High School Key Club which is sponsored by the "Downtown" Kiwanis Club of Kenosha.

### **How to Apply**

Complete application which consists of:

- A two-page application form (provided)
- A recommendation from a school counselor familiar with the applicant's academic performance (one-page form - provided)

### **Award Disbursement**

1. Notice of scholarship award will be mailed to successful candidates.
2. The recipient's school of choice will administer the scholarship funds.
3. Failure to continue with post-secondary education plans will result in the award reverting to the Foundation
4. Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation Board of Trustees in April, and scholarship awards will be presented at the Kenosha Kiwanis Club's Academic & Music Awards Luncheon, Wednesday, May 14, 2014, Madrigrano Auditorium, Gateway Technical College. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend.
