

Polly Munn Scholarship

PURPOSE

A fund has been established with the Education Foundation of Kenosha to support a yearly scholarship to provide financial assistance to an African American student who will be graduating from a Kenosha Unified School District high school this year and is interested in pursuing a college program in teacher education. The scholarship will recognize an outstanding student who is planning a career in elementary or secondary education and who is committed toward strengthening the educational opportunities for African American students.

ELIGIBILITY

Kenosha Unified School District students who intend to enroll in an accredited college or university, prepare for an elementary or secondary teaching career, and indicate interest in teaching in the Kenosha Unified School District are eligible to apply. They must be academically capable, be able to demonstrate financial need, demonstrate an interest and/or experience in working with African American students, provide evidence of college acceptance, and be U.S. citizen. Recipients are expected to maintain contact periodically with Mrs. Munn, the benefactor. She wants you to be successful and will follow your progress.

FINANCIAL DATA

The scholarship award amount is \$1,000.00 annually. A grade point average of at least a 2.50 must be maintained. The scholarship award is for five years, provided the grade average and the preparation for teaching are continued. The award is to be used for tuition, fees, and college residential costs at an accredited college or university, and will be issued directly to the university.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications may be obtained from Kenosha Unified High School guidance offices. Completed applications must be submitted by March 15th.
